Bakers Hill Primary School Student Dress Code

The School Council of Bakers Hill Primary School has established a dress code for all students attending the school.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS INFORMATION

OUR UNIFORM

The school uniform has been developed in consultation with parents and the school community. Parents are informed of the requirement to wear school uniform via the School Information Booklet upon enrolment. An order form is provided at this time. All students are expected to wear the uniform at all times whilst at school.

The School Uniform is as follows:

All Students:

- Green polo shirt, preferably with the school logo
- Green jumper or jacket preferably with the school logo
- Bottoms:
Skirts, tracksuit pants, slacks, cargo pants, shorts and shorts must be green or black without any logos, large branding or visible text.
- These items can be purchased inexpensively from major retail chains. Unbranded items are usually more affordable and are preferred.
- Checked green and white school dress for girls in Kindy to Year Three

Footwear:

Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times. Closed-in shoes that support the feet are required. Robust, strapped sandals are acceptable for Kindergarten and Pre-Primary students only during summer.

Thongs, "croc", high-heeled boots, fashion shoes or unsuitable sandals do not provide adequate protection and are not permitted. Sandals may be worn by all students during swimming lessons. ***Please note that thongs are not permitted at any time.***

HATS: No Hat Play in the Shade

At Bakers Hill Primary School, we take sun safety seriously. In line with our SunSmart policy, all students are required to wear a broad-brimmed or bucket hat throughout the year when outdoors.

The Cancer Council recommends that children wear wide-brimmed hats to help prevent sun damage while playing outside. This style provide the best protection for the face, ears and neck. Baseball caps, beanies and head scarves do not offer adequate protection and are not suitable for outdoor play.

To support the long-term health and safety of our students, the School Council requires hats to be worn year-round. Students without an appropriate hat will need to remain in a designated shaded area and will not be permitted to play in the sun.

We appreciate families supporting this important safety requirement to help keep our students protected while they enjoy outdoor activities.

GENERAL GROOMING

Students are expected to maintain a neat and tidy appearance.

- Hair must be clean and neatly presented.
- Hair that is ***shoulder length or longer must be tied back*** and off the face. This is to avoid the recurring transmission of Head Lice and Nits. Please note that school ties and ribbons are available from the P&C Uniform shop.
- Jewellery must be minimal. Acceptable items include watches (not smart watches) and small stud or sleeper earrings.
- Excessive or decorative jewellery is not permitted.
- Cosmetics are not appropriate in the school environment and should not be worn or used at school.
- Clothing and accessories must not display logos, large branding or text other than the official school logo.

UNIFORM AVAILABILITY

The Bakers Hill Primary School P&C Association coordinates the ordering and purchasing of uniforms.

Uniform order forms are available from the school office at any time and are included in the enrolment pack.

- Parents are not obliged to purchase uniforms from the P&C.
- Second-hand uniform items may be available through the school when stock permits.
- Families experiencing financial difficulty in purchasing uniform items are encouraged to contact the Principal to discuss support options.

IN CASE OF NON-COMPLIANCE

The Principal will consult with parents in an effort to encourage compliance. If this is unsuccessful, the Principal will write to parents outlining actions that will be implemented in accordance with the Department of Education Dress Code for Students Policy.

CONCLUSION

Acceptance of enrolment at Bakers Hill Primary School constitutes acceptance of the School Dress Code in accordance with the Department of Education's *Student Dress Code Policy*.

Parents and caregivers will be informed of the Dress Code at the time of enrolment. The Dress Code will be communicated regularly to the school community to ensure ongoing awareness and understanding.

The School Dress Code will be reviewed by the School Council every three years, or earlier if required, in line with Department of Education guidelines.
